

Wild Species Report - 2020
Crop Germplasm Committee

We continue to increase seed for the USDA-ARS collection in Griffin, GA, in collaboration with Dr. Shyam Tallury. These accessions that we are growing, with funding from the National Peanut Board and the Peanut Research Foundation, are mostly listed in GRIN as “not in the collection,” “no data,” “historic,” and “not available.”

The 2019 plantings consisted of 89 different accessions and many of these materials are in section *Erectoides*. These materials were planted in May and June, 2019, and some are still not harvested. The growing season for these is quite long.

The 2019 plantings included 89 different accessions.

We have started on the plantings for 2020 and I anticipate having more than 70 grown this year. We will also start transferring some vegetative materials of the non-seed producers later in 2020.
